L8R Series One – storylines and themes

The first series of L8R develops in two main storylines:






First storyline

Episodes 1, 3, 5 and 7 feature four characters and cover themes including: sex and relationships, sexual health, drug and alcohol awareness, and related issues such as self esteem and peer pressure.

Second storyline

Episodes 1, 2, 4, 6 and 8 mainly feature two characters and their baby, and cover the realities of early parenthood, fatherhood and family relationships.

In **Series Two**, we have moved on three years. We catch up with some of the characters from **Series One**, and how they have dealt with the decisions young people made for them in that series. We also introduce new characters. There are currently two episodes in this second series of L8R and these

focus on bullying and the risks and choices associated with gangs, youth crime and drugs. Later episodes will continue these, and the themes from **Series One**, including sexual health and alcohol and risky sexual behaviour.

Young people can vote to affect how the story proceeds.
